NOMINATION AND APPLICATION

Eligibility	To be eligible for a study as an exchange or a visiting student at MSU, student must have: ✓ minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0-point scale, or the equivalent; ✓ to take courses in English (for non-native English speakers): English language level equivalent to IELTS 6.0; ✓ to take subject courses in Russian: TORFL-II / B2 level of Russian language;	
Nomination Procedure for Partners	select students to be nominated. 2. Send to the academic mobility coordinator responsible for cooperation with your university in MSU an official nomination letter with the following information about each student: • Full name of the student • Email of the student. • Faculty/Department/School/Institute at home university and Study Program • Study level (Bachelor/Master/PhD) and year • MSU Faculty and Study Program the student will apply to • Period of study: Spring semester/Fall semester/Academic year 3. Inform your students about the online application procedure and deadlines in MSU, make sure that your students start collecting the documents in advance.

Application Procedure for Exchange and Visiting Students	Ask the international coordinator at your home university: to nominate you for international mobility program at MSU (if you study at MSU partner university); to approve your desire to study on international mobility program at MSU as a free-mover or to apply for signing a cooperation agreement with MSU.

	3. Upon receiving your nomination and online application, MSU Department for Internationalisation Development will assess your submitted application and will send it for approval to a particular Faculty;	
	4. Once MSU Faculty approves your application and provisional study program, MSU mobility coordinator will send you a formal acceptance e-mail with all the information. If there are any issues with your application, you will be informed about that.

Checking study calendar with the mobility coordinator is recommended.		
Course Information	Typically, an exchange student is enrolled in the host faculty in which he plans to study. Attending 1-2 additional courses at another faculty is possible but it needs to be mutually agreed in advance. Course offer and language of instruction: Most of the courses are conducted in Russian, some in English. The list of courses taught in English: https://international.msu.ru/mobility-en#english courses The list of courses taught in Russian is available at the website of each faculty: https://www.msu.ru/info/struct/#facult . Credit system: One academic semester corresponds to 30 ECTS (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System) credits. Typically, a course at MSU is estimated at 2 or 4 credits, that means the students has 36 or 72 academic (class) hours respectively or 72 or 144 hours of total workload. 1 academic hour = 45 minutes. Usual workload: Exchange students can take up to 30 ECTS per semester (60 ECTS per year). Students are encouraged to check in with their home universities for credit load requirements.		
Russian Language Classes	Some faculties may also offer Russian Language classes for exchange students during their stay at Moscow State University. It is necessary to ask the host faculty in advance whether it is possible or not.		
Grading System	The Russian grading system is based on a scale from 0 to 5, where 3 is the minimum passing mark.

Hard copies are sent upon the home university coordinator's request to the institution's address.
