Campuses at Tampere University

Tampere University has three campuses: in the city centre, Hervanta and Kauppi in Tampere. The **city centre campus** is a hub for education, business and management studies, politics, communication and social sciences. The **Hervanta campus** and the surrounding area constitute a major technology hub and is a main campus for engineering students. The **Kauppi campus** is located near the Tampere University Hospital and is the home base for medicine and health sciences. Language requirements

The required level of knowledge of English is **B2**, however, in the *Degree Programme in Languages, specialisation in English language,* the required level of English is **C1**. English-taught courses and restrictions

Tampere University offers a wide range of study options for incoming exchange students. When applying, applicants are expected to submit their preliminary study plan according to <u>courses</u> offered at Tampere University. The study field must be related or comparable to their study background at their home institution. In addition, they have the possibility to choose courses across faculties and study fields according to their own interests if they meet the course prerequisites. Access to some study fields, e.g. architecture, medicine and theatre arts is restricted to field-specific mobility agreements only.

Incoming Erasmus+ students are expected to select the majority of their courses in the subject field stated in the bilateral agreement.
