### 1) Gather the required documents

<b>Motivation letter</b>	Articulate your goals for engaging in this exchange program. You may write in either French or English.
<b>Transcripts of records</b>	Obtained in prior years of study.
<b>Certificate of French language skills</b>	<p>B1 level is mandatory, while B2 level is strongly recommended.</p> <p>For programs in Performing and Visual Arts, a C1 level is required.</p> <p>For programs in the Faculty of Letters: B2 (Undergraduate), C1 (Master's).</p> <p>Please reach out to the <a href="#">international academic coordinator</a> of your faculty to find out about the language requirements for each program.</p>
<b>A copy of your passport</b>	Your passport has to be valid until the end of your mobility period.
<b>1 ID photo</b>	Faculty of Law only.
<b>Copy of the RAMQ for students from Québec</b>	Faculty of Law only.

### 2) Finalize the application

Complete the [online application](#), submit it and download the PDF form.

Sign the downloaded form and submit the entire application as a single PDF file, including the application form and all required documents, to your home university coordinator. They will then review and sign the completed application.

Your application file must be titled as:

**"Name of your home university\_Name of the faculty in Strasbourg\_Intake semester\_LAST NAME\_First Name"**

For instance: "UNISTRA\_Faculté de Géographie\_Fall\_FLORENTZ\_Camille"

### 3) Submit the application to the University of Strasbourg

- **For exchange programs in every faculty (except IUT Robert Schuman and Faculty of Law), submit your application to the International Relations Office of your home university.** Your home university's International Relations Office will then submit the applications on our platform. We have provided them with the link beforehand.
