Dear Partners,

Warm Greetings from Chung-Ang University in the Republic of Korea!

We are pleased to inform you of our nomination and application procedures for incoming exchange students to Chung-Ang University. The number of students, conditions of the exchange, and important dates are described below.

- 1. Available Number of Exchange Student(s): Agreed number per semester based on mutual exchange student agreement.
 - * Please, contact our office in advance if you would like to send more students beyond the agreed exchange student quota per semester.
- **2.** Condition: Tuition Fee Waiver (or tuition fee-paying if agreed upon)
- **3. Campus:** Seoul and Anseong Campus. The campus is designated depending on your students' desired major. Please refer to the first part of the attached fact sheet.
 - * Exchange Students are responsible for airfare, registration card fee, and monthly living expenses which includes meals, textbooks, insurance, and other personal expenses.



4. Study Period:

- * One Semester (Fall semester, 2023 only): September 1st, 2023 ~ December 21st, 2023
- * Two Semesters (Fall and Spring semester of AY 2023/24): September 1st, 2023 ~ June, 2024 (Spring 2024 semester dates are subject to change)

5. Nomination Deadline: April 14th, 2023 (Please, use our official nomination form)

- * I have attached the nomination format for your students, so please complete the form and send it back to us by April 14th, 2023 before your students apply through the online application system. All exchange students need to be nominated by the Office of International Affairs at their home university.
- * After reviewing the nomination form, we will provide the temporary IDs and PWs of approved students to the University coordinator's e-mail.
- 6. Online Application: April 17th ~ May 12th, 2023
- *For Non-OECD nationalities, original documents should arrive by May 31st, 2023

7. Certificate of Admission(COA) issuance starts: 2nd week of June, 2023

* COA is a required document for the student visa application. It will be issued in order and the student should receive the COA by mid-July at the latest to safely obtain the student visa (usually takes 4 – 6 weeks to obtain the visa but it depends on the Visa Centre/Consulate). Any missing/late arrival of the required documents will delay the issuance of COA and the student is solely responsible for ensuring the necessary documents are uploaded well (and original documents arrive on time).

8. Courses Offered in English

9. Global Student Internship (GSI)

We offer Global Student Internship (GSI) opportunities to incoming exchange students from English, French and Chinese-speaking countries. GSI will have a chance to be a language tutor for local CAU students, become an leaders of exchange students, and support OIA official events such as Global Fair and Campus Tour.

10. Global Fair
