Objective

To encourage PhD students to conduct research on Hong Kong-related topics with a view to building a trans-regional Hong Kong Studies Research Community.

Eligibility

Current PhD students from local/non-local universities who adopt “Hong Kong” as their principal or major focus area (First-year PhD students will be given priority).

Programme

Hong Kong Studies Research School is an intensive 3-day training programme offering you:

- INTENSIVE training sessions on the most advanced research approaches and methods in respect of the major areas of Hong Kong Studies;
- EXCLUSIVE chances to present your paper* at the [Hong Kong Studies Annual Conference \(HKSAC\)](#) and get the paper published in the [Social Transformations in Chinese Societies \(STICS\)](#), subject to normal peer-review formalities;
- PRECIOUS opportunities to meet senior Hong Kong Studies scholars and exchange with PhD students from different backgrounds; and
- ATTENDANCE CERTIFICATE in recognition of your completion of programme.

**We welcome single-authored, original and unpublished papers from all humanities and social science disciplines that adopt “Hong Kong” as their principal or major focus areas.*

Mixed model of face-to-face and online participation

Owing to the COVID-19 pandemic, we tentatively decide to adopt a mixed model, with local PhD students being expected to join the whole programme through face-to-face mode in EdU campus, and non-local PhD students being expected to join the whole programme through online mode.

In case international travel has resumed to normal by February 2023 and the non-local PhD students want to make their own way to join the whole programme through face-to-face mode in EdU campus, they will be provided FREE 5-day-4-night accommodation (2-person rooms/3-person rooms) in [YHA Mei Ho House Youth Hostel](#) from 7 to 11 March 2023 (Tuesday to Saturday). Still, they will be responsible for their own transport costs between Hong Kong and their original residences, local transport costs between [YHA Mei Ho House Youth Hostel](#) and EdUHK campus/HKSAC venue, living expenses, travel and medical insurances, student visa application fee, etc.
