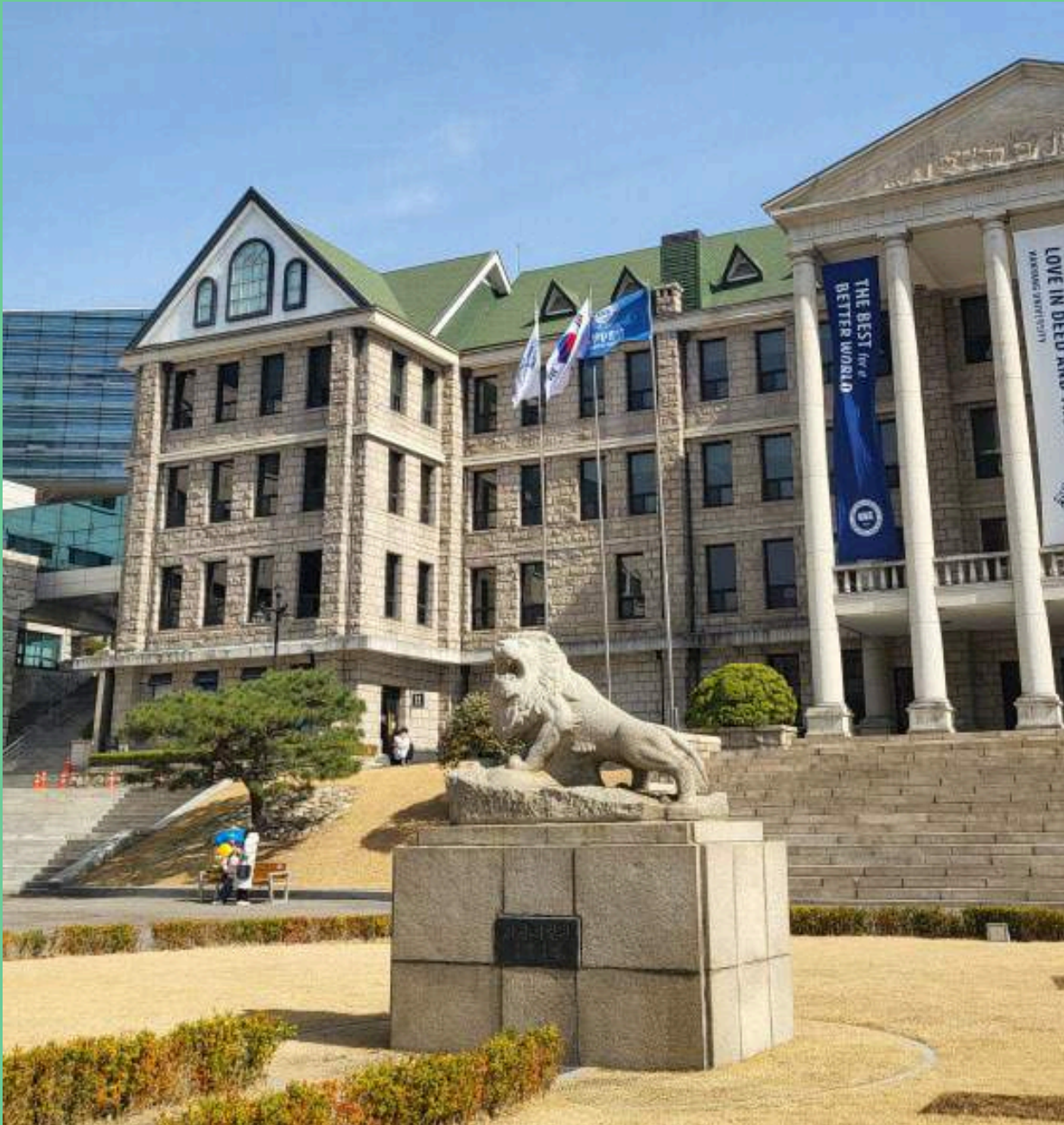

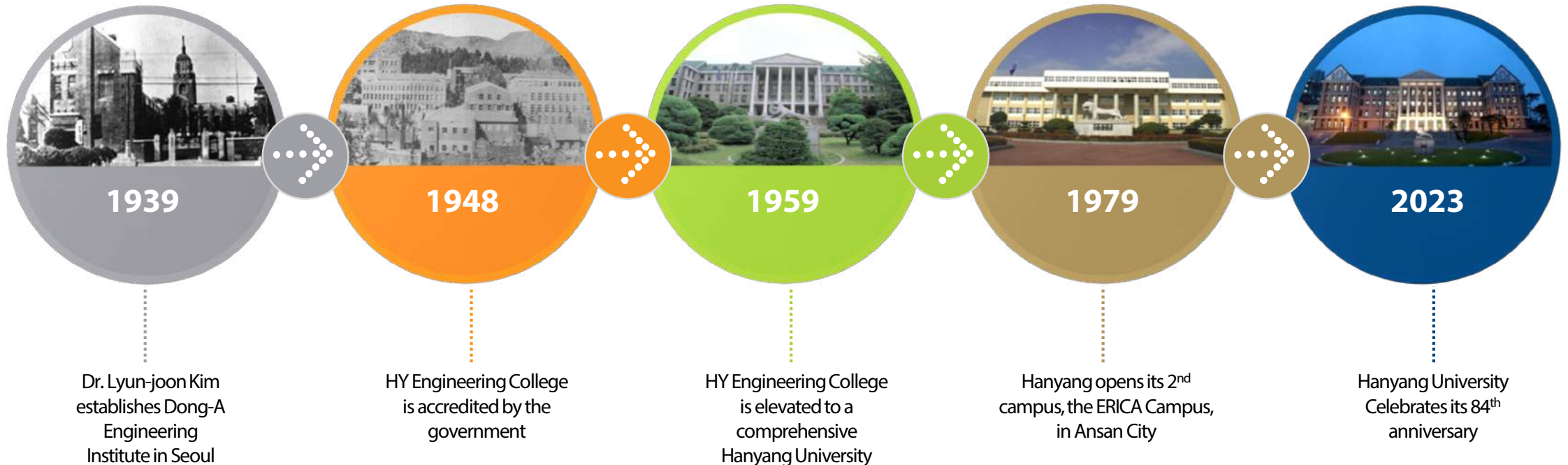

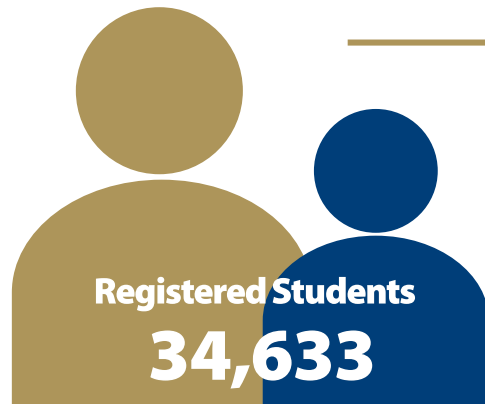
Hanyang's progress is a reflection of Korea's development

Research Project offers students opportunities to gain experience in its cutting-edge labs by participating in Research Project in the field of Engineering and Science.

Students will be able to participate in different phases of research activities such as developing research plans, conducting research, analyzing data and presenting research result.

(Group rate : around CNY 150)

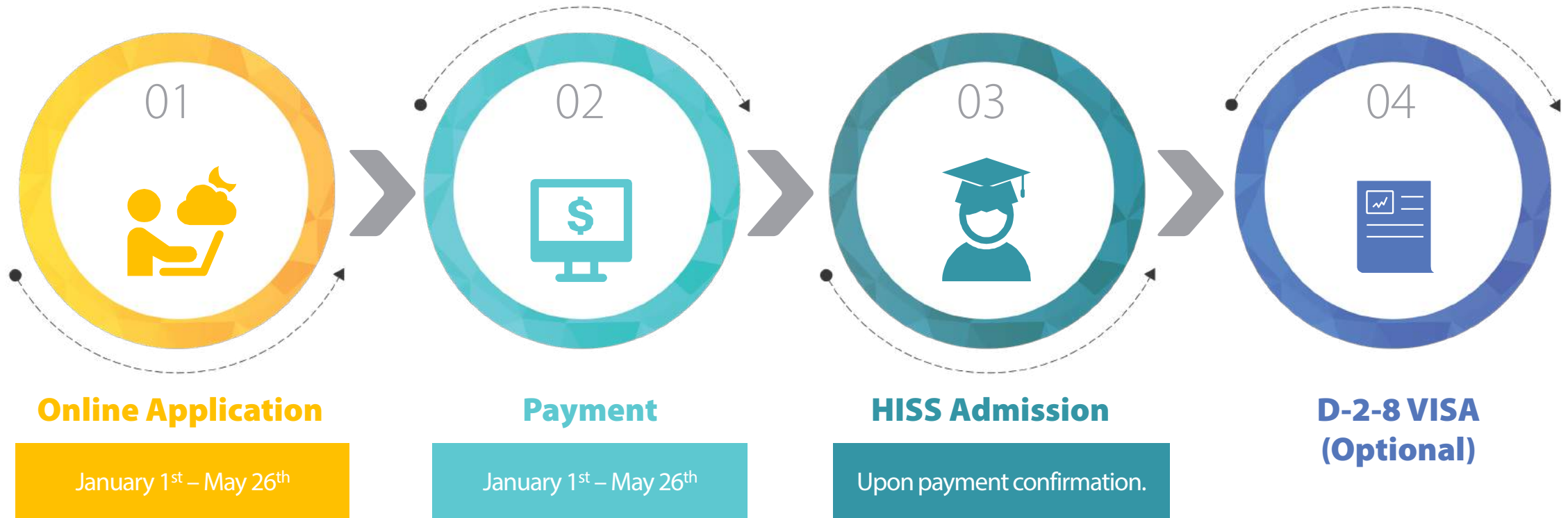

**Easy and simple, all on-line!**

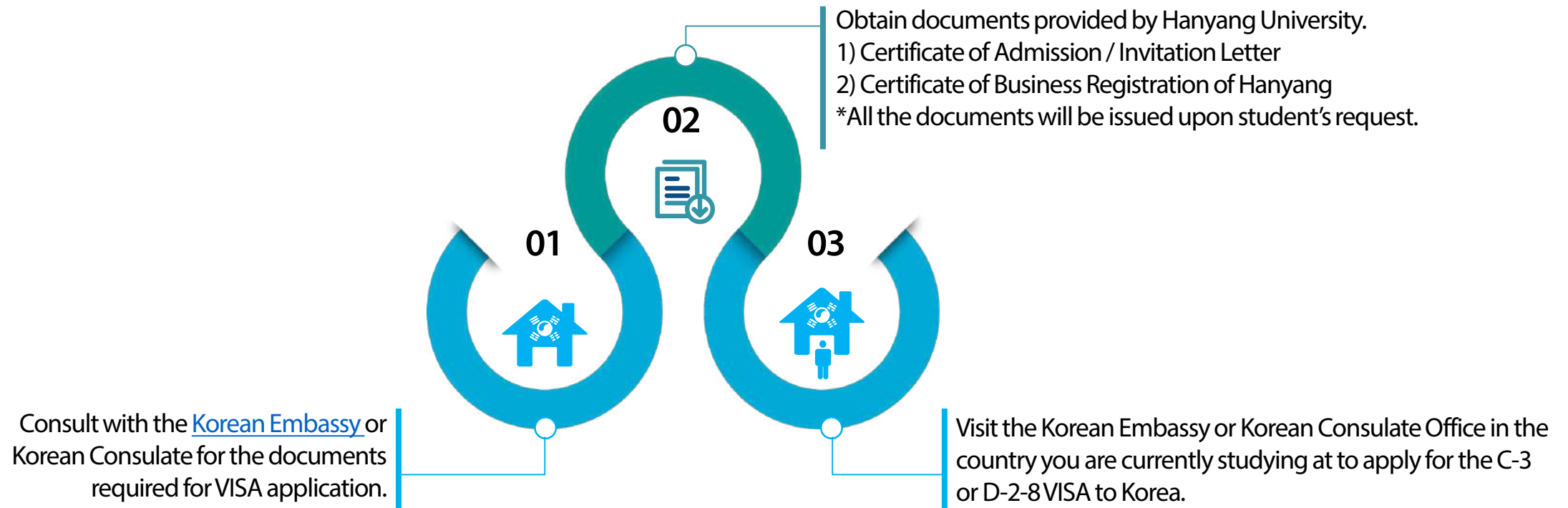


Only students who have completed payment will be eligible for course registration. Please avoid last minute payments as they may take time to track. Late-paying students may be required to email a bank transaction receipt to proceed to the next step.

## VISA

## K-ETA / C-3 Tourist Visa

- Students from a visa-waiver country need to apply for [K-ETA](#)(Korea Electronic Travel Authorization) prior to your boarding.
- Students from countries that are excluded from the Visa Waiver Agreement program must apply for a tourist visa (C-3).
- Students who wish to stay longer than your tourist visa expiry date may request for D-2-8 student visa.
