

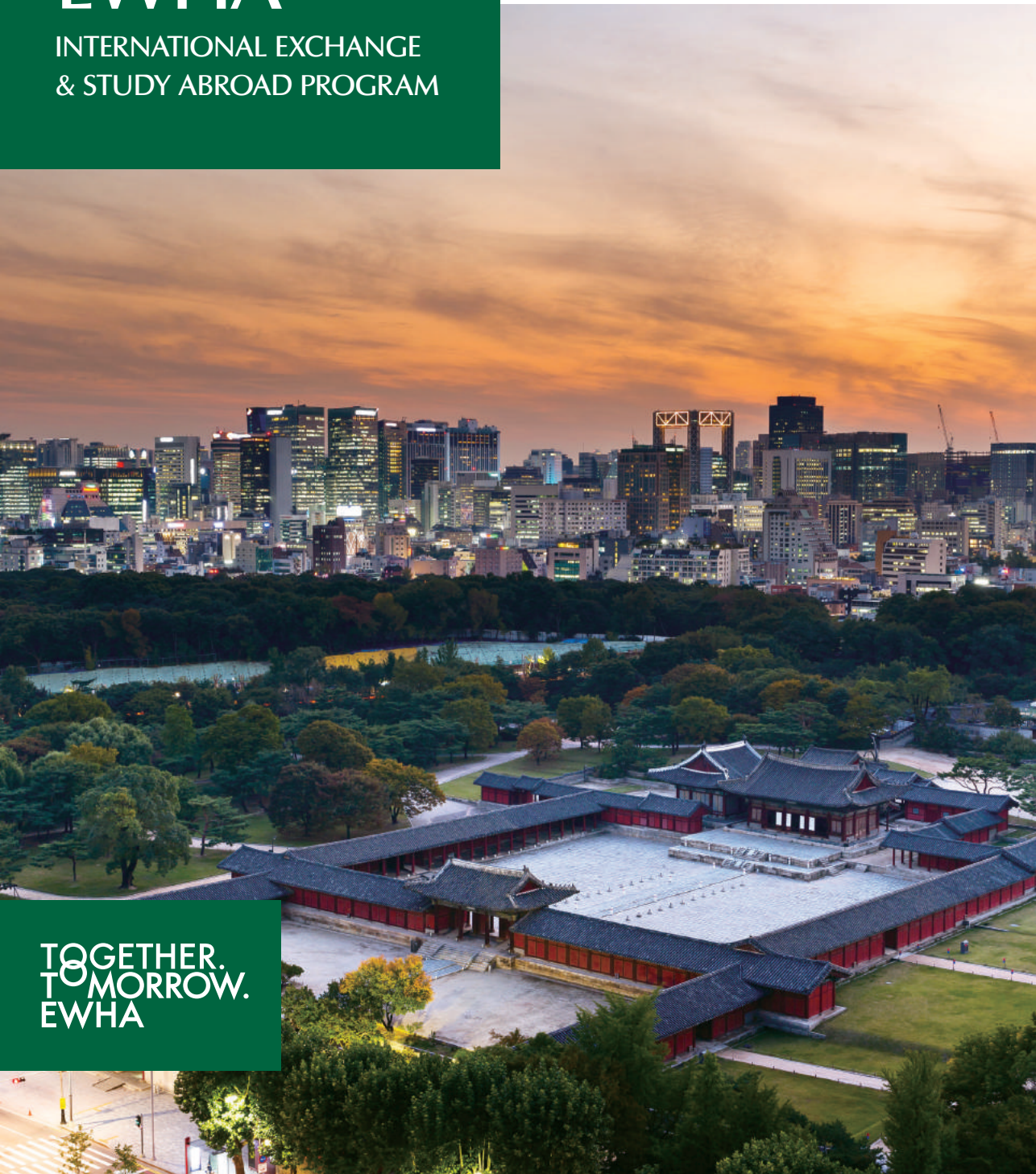

Founded in **1886**, Ewha Womans University is Korea’s very first higher education institution for women.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Full-time undergraduate or graduate students in an accredited university or equivalent
2. Students who have completed at least one semester at home university with GPA of 2.5/4.0 (75/100) or above
3. Students with language ability to take courses in either English or Korean

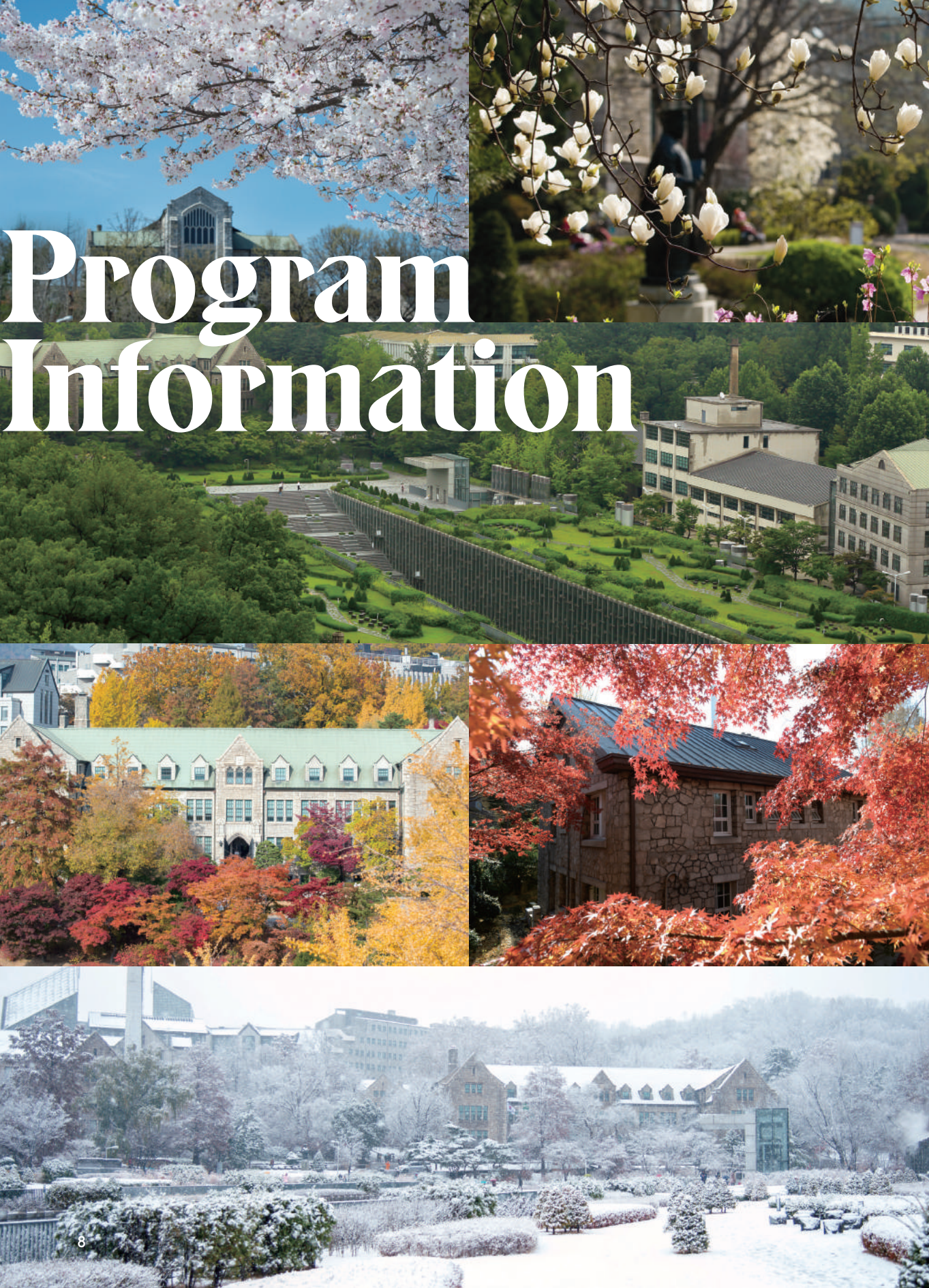

VISA AND SOJOURN MATTERS

Students are responsible for applying and receiving visa, and abiding by immigration regulations. Ewha Office of International Affairs will provide the necessary document for D-2-6 visa.

VISA	All international student: D-2-6 visa Korean passport holder: visa is not required People of Korean Heritage: F-4 visa
ALIEN REGISTRATION CARD	All international students with D-2-6 visa MUST apply for an Alien Registration Card within 90 days of their arrival.

Academic Korean	6	6 Levels: Level 1~4, Academic Korean 1&2	- Aimed to prepare students for successful <u>academic pursuits</u> - 12 hrs/week
Practical Korean	3	4 Levels: Beginner, Elementary, Intermediate, Advanced	- Aimed to prepare basic Korean needed for <u>everyday life</u> - 6 hrs/week

Undergraduate Level	General courses are available . - Restriction may apply to Art & Design, Music, ELTEC Engineering, Scranton Honors Program, Education. - Nursing, Medicine, Pharmacy are not available.
Graduate Level	The Graduate School courses are available . - Some courses in the Graduate School of International Studies are available . - English-taught courses of School of Law are available . - Courses in the Graduate School of Business courses are available for graduate students only . - The Professional Schools, the Special Graduate Schools are not available, except those mentioned above.
