Application

Application Period

January 13 (Mon) - May 16 (Fri), 2025

Eligibility

- ◆ Students currently enrolled in an accredited college/university
- ◆ Academically motivated high school students (age 18+ in Year 12*) or high school graduates
*last year in high school

Required Documents

- ◆ Copy of academic transcript
- ◆ Copy of passport
- ◆ Proof of health insurance (for students enrolled in in-person courses only)
- ◆ Consent letter signed by a legal guardian (for pre-college students only)

Application Procedures

1. Complete the online application form at summer.korea.ac.kr
(course selection to be completed through the online application form)
2. Pay the application fee of KRW 100,000 (non-refundable)
3. Send the required documents to isc@korea.ac.kr
4. Receive the 'Letter of Acceptance'
5. Pay the tuition and all remaining fees

Credit Transfer

Credits earned at KU ISC are widely transferrable to most overseas institutions at the discretion of students' home institution. For credit transfer, students are advised to consult with the appropriate academic authorities at their home institution in advance by submitting the course syllabus available from the KU ISC website.

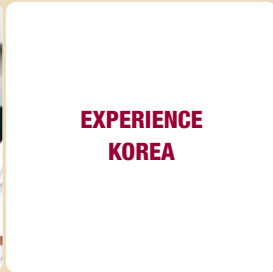
