

CANCELLATIONS

The updated cancellation policy will be included in the Letter of Agreement provided to your University or program. Cancellation requests after each session's cancellation deadline will incur a \$300 cancellation fee per student.

LOCATIONS

The residential complexes are located only two to three short blocks south of the main campus. Features that are included in the package rate of all Summer Sessions Housing locations:

- A flexible Standard Meal Plan with an option to upgrade to a Premium Meal Plan (price varies by Session) EXCEPT any Apartments
- Wireless internet is available in all rooms, lounge spaces, and common areas
- Student Staff live in the halls and provide support, leadership, activities, and social programs
- Comfortable lounges where you can relax, study, watch television, or socialize
- Double/triple occupancy residence hall room or a single/double occupancy apartment room with oak furniture, cable, wall-to-wall carpeting, and large windows. Each bedroom offers extra-long twin single beds and/or bunk beds, desks, desk chairs, dressers, shelving, mirrors, and closets.
- Apartments with a shared kitchen feature a standard refrigerator, microwave, stove, four burners, kitchen table, and chairs
- Laundry Facilities

Double and triple occupancy rooms are located in high-rise towers in the Unit 3 Residence Halls. Each residence hall building has a bathroom on every floor, four floor lounges with balconies, and a main lounge with a television and comfortable furnishings for relaxing.

LINEN

Linen will not be provided in the residence halls or apartments. Students may purchase a linen rental packet and have that included into the housing cost. Should your students like to have linen delivered to their room before arrival, please note that I will need payment and a complete list of your students 6 weeks prior to their move-in.

Students are welcome to bring their own linen as well. Beds in the Berkeley residence halls are specially sized extra-long twin beds, and standard sheets will not fit properly.

*Session E/F Rates: Priority is given to groups wanting Session E & F as long as they are filling both Session E/F so there is a continual stay.

**If a student lives in an apartment (which doesn't include a meal plan) the student can purchase a non-resident summer meal plan through UC Berkeley Dining if they wish. A summer non-resident meal plan is \$300 for 300 points. Students will then be able to load 55 points for \$50 at any time after.

INDIVIDUAL ARRANGEMENTS

You can have your students apply individually for on-campus housing and pay individually.

The 2025 Summer Sessions Housing application is located at portal.housing.berkeley.edu and will be available beginning February 1, 2025. Either a credit card or a Cashier's Check payable to "UC Regents" is an acceptable form of payment for individual applications. We do **not** accept Bank/Wire Transfer payments for individual student fees.

To apply online, a student must be an enrolled student at UC Berkeley. They will need to have their 10-digit Student Identification Number (SID), and CalNet ID and Passphrase set up in order to log into the application.
